A vacancy exists within the Family Crimes Section for a Contract Service Specialist I.

Responsibilities:

Working as part of a dynamic team and under general supervision, the successful candidate will maintain the domestic violence reports database via Lotus Notes. The Family Crimes Unit processes approximately 9,000 - 10,000 domestic violence reports a year. The Contract Specialist will be responsible for administrative functions including but not limited to:

- Inspecting domestic violence reports for compliance with departmental procedures.
- Entering domestic violence reports into Lotus Notes and maintaining the domestic violence database.
- Ensuring correct and prompt service of criminal background investigations.
- Maintaining and providing statistical data and reports to appropriate agencies.
- Working to streamline procedures to increase efficiencies and effectiveness of the BPD domestic violence response.
- Providing prompt, safe and effective ways to assist victims of domestic violence.

Minimum Requirements:

- Retired Baltimore City Police Officer
- Graduation from an accredited high school or possession of a high school equivalency certificate
- Experience performing data entry
- Proficient in the use of Lotus Notes and Microsoft Office products (Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Outlook)
- Outstanding interpersonal skills
- Excellent organizational skills
- Ability to effectively manage time with limited supervision
