Position Announcement: Homicide Advocate Vacancy

The Office of the State's Attorney is seeking to fill the position of Homicide Advocate for its Victim/Witness Unit. This is a grant-funded position. The Victim/Witness Unit provides victims and witnesses of crime with information about the case in which they are involved as well as provide assistance and services to victims and witnesses throughout the criminal justice process. This full-time position is located at 120 E. Baltimore Street, Baltimore, MD. The selected candidate will be expected to start within 30 days of offer.

The Homicide Advocate obtains police reports, secures next of kin contact information for purposes of outreach, advises homicide survivors of services available to them, schedules and attends meetings with homicide survivors, and other pertinent parties when requested, assigns advocates to upcoming court cases, maintains statistics for all homicide survivors assisted provides case updates, emotional support, court accompaniment, safety planning and crisis intervention to homicide survivors and family members and performs other related duties.

This is an at-will position with no civil service protection.

Qualifications:

Preferred applicants will have a bachelor's degree in psychology, criminal justice, social work, sociology, or a related field. Additional training in counseling techniques, crisis intervention, victimology, homicide or grieving situation is also preferred. Applicant must have at least one year of crisis intervention experience or similar experience relating to victims of crime.
