Financial plans include both revenue and spending initiatives, meaning that the analyst is involved in a wide array of city government issues. The analyst will serve the Bureau of the Budget and Management Research and will be part of a new Revenue and Long-Term Financial Planning Team.

This position requires a Master's degree from an accredited college or university with advanced coursework in economics, statistics, public policy analysis, business administration, management, or related fields. At least four years of experience in operational and financial analysis, forecasting and modeling, research, systems design, strategic planning, and other management analyses is preferred. Strong facilities with computer software and skill in quantitative methods are essential.
