Position Announcement: Social Worker LGSW Vacancy (Grant Funded)

The Office of the State's Attorney is seeking to fill the position of Social Worker for its Family Bereavement Center. This is a grant funded position. The Family Bereavement Center provides support to families of homicide victims. This full-time position is located at 120 East Baltimore St., Baltimore, Md. 21202. The selected candidate will be expected to start within 30 days of offer and must be willing to work a flexible schedule, including some evenings.

The Social Worker conducts individual and family counseling sessions for relatives of homicide victims, facilitates adult support group sessions, accompanies clients to Court, assists clients with obtaining services from social service agencies, develops and maintains treatment plans and case files, and performs other related duties as required. This is an at-will position with no civil service protection.

Qualifications:

Applicants must be licensed as a graduate social worker (or higher) by the Maryland Board of Social Work Examiners and must have at least one year of assessment and counseling experience, of which 6 months may be as an intern. Experience in the criminal justice system is preferred. Applicants must possess excellent oral and written communication skills, be highly organized and be able to meet deadlines. Selected candidate will be required to submit to drug and alcohol testing as well as a criminal background check before starting employment.

Salary: \$48,812 - \$59,437 depending upon experience. Benefits are associated with this position.
